Level of Service/ Case Management Inventory (LS/CMI) is the successor to LSI-R. It is a general risk assessment tool which also enables practitioners to develop an effective case management plan. The tool is currently being adapted for use in Scotland to include sections for considering the risk of serious harm and building a risk management plan. There are plans to roll out the use of this tool throughout Scotland, in both community and prison based settings - between 2008 and 2009.
